"DEED POLL RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS FROM LIABILITY"

All NHMA member clubs are advised that the above document is now available for their club's use.

The use of the above document (by NHMA member clubs) was discussed at a recent Committee of Management meeting. It was resolved that the HH Deed Poll be offered to all member clubs so that the best possible protection would be available to NHMA Clubs, holding events that may have exhibitors/participants that are unable to produce a current NHMA insurance card.

Certificates of Currency offer little information other than that the cover mentioned is current and the limit of the cover in dollar terms & possibly the location where the cover applies.

The NHMA does not expect member clubs or committees to be able understand or interpret policy wordings/insurance schedules on the spot at the rally gate. The "DEED POLL RELEASE & HOLD HARMLESS FROM LIABILITY" document is the best way for the 'non-NHMA exhibitor' to say, that 'he/she is comfortable with the insurance that they hold' and that in the event of an incident/injury occurring, they will not hold the NHMA Host Club responsible for any claim that may arise from this incident/injury.

The HH Deed Poll and instructions on its use can be emailed to any NHMA member club requesting a copy for a given event. When requesting the document, please indicate the date and the event name; the secretary will make out your club's copy accordingly.

If your club is holding an event prior to the 31st October 2017, please contact the NHMA Secretary or President ASAP. Your request will receive top priority.
